□ ATTRIBUTES OF GOD

Use this list of God's attributes to bring comfort to you as you serve. May these truths motivate you to persevere in your service.

- **Eternal** – God has no beginning and no end. He always was, is, and always will be.
- **Sovereign** – God governs over all things; He is in complete control.
- **Just** – God rules with perfect justice. He acts in accordance with justice. In Him, there is no wrongdoing or dishonesty.
- **Good** – God is pure; there is no defilement in Him. He is unable to sin, and all He does is good.
- **Holy** – God is undefiled and cannot be in the presence of sin. He is sacred and set apart.
- **Faithful** – God is incapable of anything but fidelity. He is loyally devoted to His plan and purpose.
- **Love** – God is eternally, enduringly, and steadfastly loving and affectionate. He does not forsake or betray His covenant love.
- **Gracious** – God is kind, giving us gifts and benefits we do not deserve.
- **Merciful** – God is compassionate, withholding from us the wrath we deserve.
- **True** – God is the measure of all truth. By Him, we discern what is true and false.
- **Immutable** – God does not change. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
- **Righteous** – God is blameless and upright. There is no wrongdoing in Him.
- **Omnipresent** – God is everywhere; His presence is near and all-encompassing.
- **Omniscient** – God is all-knowing; nothing is unknown to Him.
- **Omnipotent** – God is all-powerful; His strength is unlimited.
